We go on about not really liking the Australians, but they write great stories! I surf. Perhaps not the best book for taking on a surf roadie, but the book really isn't wholly about sharks, although they get a mention. I am giving this one the thumbs up! Floaty Boy is an anti-hero among heroes for modern surfers, not just because he doesn't use a board (hence his name); but because he is an outsider, an independent soul = the essence of being a surfer. A cracking plot describes Floaty Boy's existence, his fights with his parents, particularly The Old Man, a sort of father who thinks of his son as a friend, but needs to think of him as his son. I can't speak highly enough of the descriptiveness of the language that D'Arcy has used. It seems as if you have travelled over the Tasman to be floating next to Floaty Boy, ready for the next wave, watchin' for them fins!

Eleven year-old Floaty-boy (so named because of his passion for body-surfing and peculiar talent for buoyancy) inhabits a murky, watery world of wagging school and illicit night surfing. He hovers on the edge of things; he is in between; not boy or man; and inhabits liminal spaces: the edge of the ocean when he body-surfs and the edges of a family that seems to be spinning out of control. Vulnerable, Floaty-boy is as prey to his altered dream-like perceptions of the world as he is to the sharks that cruise in the other world of down below. At the centre of Floaty-boy's universe is Adelaide; mother, wife, surfer, and breadwinner; who holds not only her own family together but the knockabout Cronies of her larrikin husband, the Old Man. Yet when her eldest son, Eddie, disappears, her family's world threatens to fall apart; her centre may not hold and Floaty-boy has to find a way to cope.

About the Author Brett D'Arcy was born in Perth in 1963. He has worked as a barman, an English tutor and an antiques and collectables scout. Former passions include surfing and vintage motorcycles, although these days he just writes. His first novel, The Book of Lonely, has been optioned for a feature film. His second novel, The Mindless Ferocity of Sharks, was shortlisted for the Western Australian Premier's Book Awards 2004.
